



## **BMW Car Club Victoria, Car Display Policy**

**August 2018**

### **Objectives**

The purpose of a Club Register is to ensure we have the best possible display of member's cars at events & give BMWCCV members the best opportunity to participate.

### **Specific Guidelines**

Selection will not be based on 'first in - first served' basis.

Where entry numbers are limited - i.e. Motoclassica, F1 Grand Prix Display, Geelong Revival & others:

Events with limited numbers will be open to BMWCCV members only,

These events will require an expression of interest from members by a specified cut-off date.  
No entries will be accepted after that date.

Only one entry per member,

Selection of nominated cars will be by 2 independent people, at least one of which must be a committee member, to help select those cars to go on display, taking consideration of:

A cross section of excellent & unique BMW models, and where possible, a variety of colours.  
Avoid duplication of same model type.

Consideration will be given to members who are prepared to be with the car display and interface with the public and promote the club as an ambassador of BMWCCV.

Members may register multiple cars for selection, however when the event has limited numbers, only one car per member will be selected.

For limited numbers events, those not selected will go on a wait list & may gain an entry subject to another member's cancellation,

Where similar cars are proposed, a general club member will be given priority over a Committee member's entry.

Members & their selected display cars are to be at the meeting point nominated by the event coordinator, on or before the required time.

If a member is unable to attend, notice is to be given to the event coordinator at least 12 hours prior, unless due to some unforeseen event or emergency.

Members are not allowed to substitute their selected display car for an alternative car without prior approval of the event coordinator.

Members are to bring their vehicle in display condition i.e. washed & as clean as possible.  
The event coordinator has the right to remove or disallow any vehicle not suitably presented.  
Concourse or show car condition is not expected, other than for our annual Show of Excellence where members should detail their vehicle to their best possible standard.

The promotion of any businesses of individual members who may have a car on display, by way of flags, banners, brochures, signage or the like is not allowed unless by prior arrangement or part of an agreed sponsorship package. Permanent signage on race cars is accepted.
